

## How to Post a Blog Entry

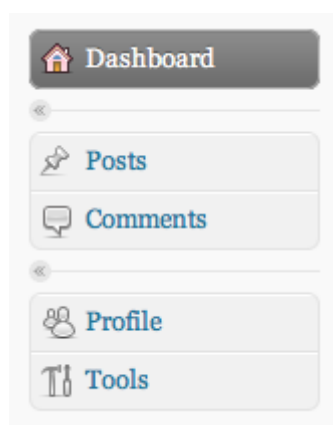
Check your email for your password.

Log in at <http://scorpiolicious.com/wp-admin>

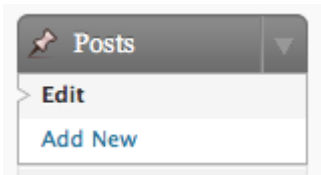

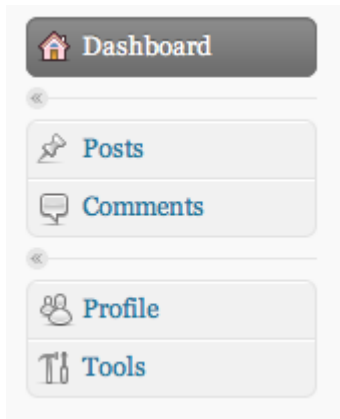
**Save your draft if you need to, and then "Submit for Review."**

# How to Change Your Profile

In the dashboard, click on "Profile."



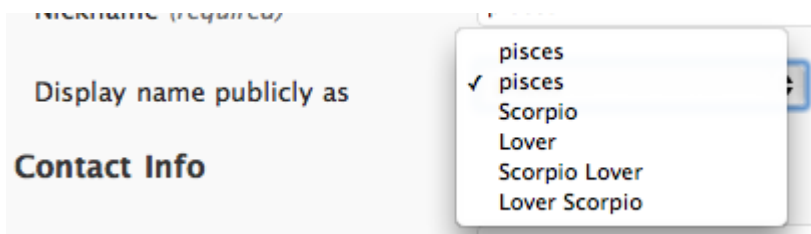
If you like your displayed name to be different than your username, enter your name in the appropriate fields.

Username	<input type="text" value="pisces"/>
First name	<input type="text" value="Scorpio"/>
Last name	<input type="text" value="Lover"/>
Nickname <i>(required)</i>	<input type="text" value="pisces"/>
Display name publicly as	<input type="text" value="pisces"/>

You can also scroll to the bottom of the page to create a new password.

Click on "Update Profile."

Go back to the drop-down menu next to "Display name publicly as"



Choose the name you want, and click "Update Profile" again.
